

**MINERAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
PUBLIC HEARING FOR
SHERLAW AVENUE RIGHT-OF-WAY ABANDONMENT REQUEST
DECEMBER 15, 2017**

The hearing will be held at 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Conference Room located in the Courthouse Annex, 300 River Street, Superior, to take comments in regards to the proposed abandonment of a portion of Sherlaw Avenue right-of-way.

Jerry and Dawn Bauer, owners of Lots 13 through 18 of Block 66, Jeff and Lola Wright, owners of Lots 7 through 12 of Block 66, Bruce and Mary Jo Berry, owners of Lots 1 through 8 of Block 67 and Aaron and Ronna LaPierre, owners of Lots 9 through 12 of Block 67 of the Amador Townsite, have petitioned the Mineral County Commissioners to abandon a portion of Sherlaw Avenue extending from the Northeast most boundary of Block 66 and the Northeast most boundary of Block 67 extending into the Sherlaw Avenue for a width of twenty feet (20) running parallel to the east boundary of Block 66 and the west boundary of Block 67 and bordering Lots 7 through 18 of Block 66 and Lots 1 through 12 of Block 66, located in the Amador Townsite, Book of Townsites number six (6).

The property owners are requesting permanent abandonment of the above-referenced right-of-way.
