

RESOLUTION NO. 01-24-2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE MINERAL COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH TO ADOPT FEES FOR ACTIVITIES REQUIRED FOR SEWER PERMITS UNDER THE MINERAL COUNTY WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEM REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO 50-2-116, M.C.A.

WHEREAS, in April of 2016, the Mineral County Board of Health, Superior, Montana adopted the Mineral County Wastewater Treatment Regulations for Mineral County to provide Mineral County with regulations that comply with minimum standards set forth by the State of Montana, utilize current technology for on-site wastewater treatment and associated fees pursuant to Montana Code Annotated Title 50, Chapter 2, Part 116 et seq; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2019 the Mineral County Board of Health, Superior, Montana, held a properly noticed public hearing on the proposed fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, The Mineral County Board of Health, Superior Montana, met in regular session in the Commissioners' meeting room, on December 13, 2019, and upon motion duly made, approved, and adopted a Resolution of Intent to Adopt the revised Mineral County Wastewater Treatment System Regulations Schedule of Fees; and

WHEREAS, The Mineral County Board of Health, Superior Montana, met in regular session in the Commissioners' meeting room, on January 24, 2020, and upon motion duly made, approved, and adopted the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Mineral County Board of Health has given consideration for updating the Schedule of Fees of the Wastewater Treatment System Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Schedule of Fees of the Wastewater Treatment System Regulations will provide Mineral County with an update Schedule of Fees that reflects surrounding counties Schedule of Fees; and

WHEREAS, after considering the recommendations of the Board of Health and public testimony, the Mineral County Board of Health passed a Resolution to adopt the Schedule of Fees.


