

# COVID-19 Vaccination Event Update

**Current Phase:** Open to all individuals age 18\* and older (Effective April 1, 2021)

## Who:

- Serving all individuals age 18 and older who reside or work in Mineral County
- \* Individuals age 16 and older are eligible to receive Pfizer vaccine; however, Mineral County does not have any Pfizer vaccine so the age of eligibility is listed as 18.

## How:

- Appointment Only
- Online Registration using a system called PrepMod. Scheduling links will be posted online.
- If you are unable to register online call the Mineral Community Hospital at 822-4841 for assistance Monday-Friday 8:00 AM-5:00 PM. The Mineral County Health Department will not be registering patients.

## Next Steps:

- Monitor the Mineral County Health Department Facebook page, Mineral County Website or the Mineral Community Hospital for registration links for currently available vaccine clinics.
- Registration links will “go live” at 12:00 PM on Tuesdays.

## Frequently Asked Questions:

- What if I don't have internet access?**
  - Ask a friend, relative or neighbor to assist.
  - Call the Mineral Community Hospital at 822-4841 Monday-Friday 8:00 AM-5:00 PM.
- Which vaccine will I receive?**
  - The type of vaccine offered will be listed with the registration links. If more than one type is offered, be sure to select the correct type.
- How do I prepare to register online?**
  - Follow these instructions:
    - o Use Google Chrome or Microsoft Edge. Internet Explorer cannot be used.
    - o Prepare ahead: you will need demographic/health information and an email address.

- What if I am unable to sign up for a vaccine?**
  - Likely, because available appointments have already been filled or you are using an incorrect internet browser.
  - Additional clinics will be open for registration Tuesdays at 12:00 PM as vaccine becomes available.
