

MINERAL COUNTY FLOODPLAIN DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

PUBLIC NOTICE – April 9, 2025

The Mineral County Environmental Health and Planning Department received a Floodplain Development Permit application from HDR Engineering for portions of Sections 2,3,4,5,11 and 12, Township 19N, Range 32W, P.M.M., Mineral County, Montana in regards to the Mineral County Floodplain Regulations. The proposed scope of the overall project is a surfacing reconstruction of I-90 to the geometry and standards in place at the time of original construction or inclusion in the interstate. The project will replace the existing plant mix bituminous surface with Portland Cement Concrete Pavement (PCCP) to construct a more durable highway surface. Other project components include improvements to storm water infrastructure and drainage, as well as other traffic and safety improvements.
