General Notice

The Mineral County Commissioners Office (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Lozeau Bridge Selective Rehabilitation

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Mineral County Clerk & Recorder Office** located at **300 River Street, Superior, MT or mailed to P.O. Box 550 Superior, MT 59872** until **March 18th, 2026 at 10:00 am** local time. Bids will be opened by the Mineral County Commissioners on March 19th at 10 am.

The Project includes the following Work:

The Mineral County Commissioners has identified the Lozeau Bridge (MDT Bridge # - 03694) as a structure in need of selective rehabilitation aimed at extending the life span of the structure. The structure, located near Lozeau, MT (Lat: 47d 06' 58.88", Long: -114d 46' 54.78") was originally constructed in 1944 and spans over the Clark Fork River. The existing structure consists of eight simple spans. Spans 1-3 and Spans 6 & 7 are composed of a timber stringer girder superstructure with a timber plank deck. Spans 4 and 5 consist of a steel truss superstructure. All substructure units consist of concrete piers. General improvements consist of, but are not limited to, the following: Removal and replacement of the existing bearing assembly at Pier 5, removal, and replacement of a single timber stringer on Span 7 along with the associated damaged bridge barrier railing. Associated work included with the removal and replacement of the Pier 5 bearing assembly includes the following: Removal and replacement of the existing bridge railing in the area adjacent to Pier 5, removal and replacement of the existing transverse glulam deck panels and timber plank decking in the area adjacent to Pier 5, removal and replacement of an existing utility conduit in the area adjacent to Pier 5.
